On the Yorke Peninsula, along the road between Maitland and Port Victoria, there's a quite ordinary looking paddock. And yet in many ways, it's an extraordinary paddock too.

You see, many years ago a generous farmer leased it (and since been purchased) to the Maitland Lutheran School, as a way of raising money during the school's infancy. Every year since then, Lutheran farmers of the district have freely given: time and machinery for ploughing, grain for seeding, fertiliser and pest spray, and harvesters and trucks for reaping the crop. These farmers each have their own land to work, but they willingly give not only to the school, but also through this they give thanks to God for the generous harvest he provides in their district.

And God has generously blessed the farmers and especially the crop in this paddock. Even during years of drought, 'God's paddock', as it has become known, has always had a better than average harvest. And all of the grain cheque goes to the work of the Lutheran School, enabling the spreading of God's saving grace to all of the children and families associated with the school.

Help us to be generous likewise, and give willingly from the bounty God has given to us.

Pastor's Column

Have you remembered that it is **our Harvest Thanksgiving celebration** today?

You might have been reminded by attending our Friday morning worship where we celebrated harvest thanksgiving with the school community.

You can't help but notice as you come into worship this morning. (Thanks worship team, especially Susanne for the wonderful display.)

Our first reading this morning (**Deuteronomy 8:7-13**) encourages us not to forget God. It was a message to God's people as they were about to make a new beginning in the Promised Land and is most relevant to us as we enter this new year of opportunities.

The trouble they had, which we also share is that in many ways, we have it too good! Yes, things go wrong but don't we have a lot for which to be thankful? It's all the stuff we have and the opportunities before us that distract us from God and we fall into that trap of forgetting God instead of: remembering him and what he has done for us and what he has given us and in response, thanking him.

This is what we are going to look more closely at this morning in the address entitled "**Don't forget God"**.

What better way to say thanks to God than to "*Tell it like it is*"- to hone our skills of witnessing our faith so that others can come to know Christ...and thank God for what he has done. Irwin Traeger the seminar's presenter, will be giving us a glimpse of the seminar in worship this morning after which we shall pray for him and the seminar.

Another feature of this service (and something else for which we can be thankful) is the installation of our **Children's Ministry Coordinator**, Sarah Williams. Sarah has taken on coordinating our children's ministry especially on a Sunday morning which, at this stage, is centred around the Kid's Craft Table.

Another way to thank God is by supporting our fishing club (GGAF) which, as part of our congregation, has as its anchor our statement of mission **Knowing Christ and making Him known**. GGAF's Annual General Meeting is in the Fellowship Centre at 4.30 this afternoon. (As I said last week at a slightly later time to allow you to attend the witness workshop before attending the AGM -perhaps a few minutes late.)

Also as I announced last Sunday, **you may take any books in the old pastor's study** (now the extended Fellowship Lounge)... *and keep them.* I have taken out any that I would like to keep and a couple of ALC students have taken out books they would like or would like to pass on to others. It's over to you. Those books which are not snapped up will be donated to a book stall that we are holding later in the year. (*One more week before the book disappear off the shelves.*)


