Recently our LCA SA-NT District Synod was held on 25th May at Salisbury Lutheran Church.

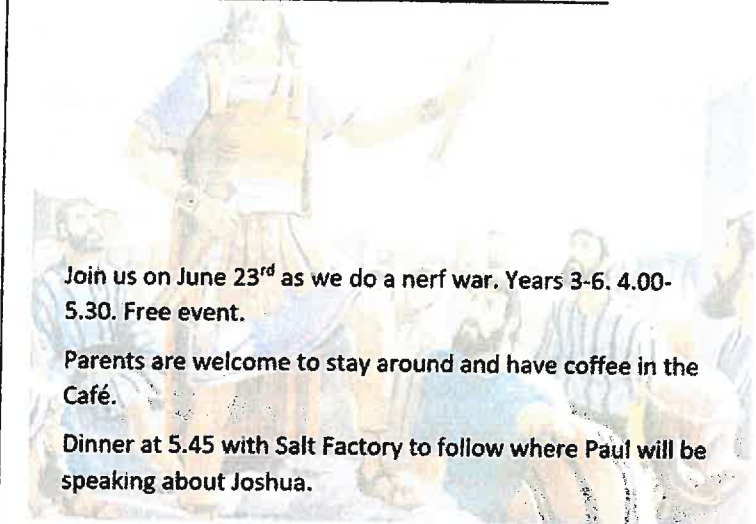
Rosalie Hoklas was our congregational representative and as part of her role now shares the Synod Report together with Bishop Altus' opening message.

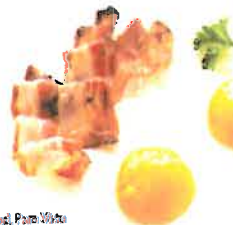
Dr Michael Findlay Co-Founder of Maranatha Health

Holy Trinity

Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Mathew 28:18-19

There are many things about God that we cannot understand. How can God be present everywhere at the same time? How can God exist in the eternal present so that past, present and future are all the same to him? And how can we get our heads around the fact that God is three persons in one God? Fortunately, our faith is based on the revelation of God in the person of Jesus Christ, his words and his actions. Our day-to-day life is not affected by our ability to unravel the mysteries of God but it is good for us to meditate on these mysteries to grow in our love of Him.

It took the church many centuries to come to an agreed confession of God in three persons, i.e. the doctrine of the Holy Trinity. Essentially, we believe that God the Father, Jesus his only begotten Son and the Holy Spirit are all fully God in their own right as well as being joined together in mutual will as one God. We experience all three persons in our Christian life. God the Father, as creator and sustainer, is seen in everything around us. Jesus' incarnation means that we can enjoy a real relationship with God as he showed himself as a human. We, individually and as church, are empowered and guided by the Holy Spirit.

As we read the word of God, pray and ponder his awe and majesty, we are thankful that our God is available to us as three persons. We are thankful that God chose to come into our world, deal with our alienation from God and live in us through his Holy Spirit. Praise God for his goodness.
