In What do we Trust?

I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ—the righteousness that comes from God on the basis of faith.

Philippians 3:8-9

Many people in Paul's time were proud of their abilities, their heritage and their dedication to God. Because they believed that it was up to us to be right with God, they concentrated on what they could do rather than what Jesus could do. This led to lots of comparisons where those who had the right 'credentials' could look down on others.

Paul rejects this notion as fool hardy and unhealthy. He restates the gospel message again and again; it is the righteousness we have in Christ that surpasses all others. And because that is true, we do not boast of our own accomplishments, we point to Jesus. Paul knew that depending on ourselves can lead to a distortion of God's law and comparisons can fracture any community.

We too need to be on guard. Do we completely trust Jesus or do we look to our actions and abilities? When it comes to our salvation, there is only one way; by the grace of God through faith in Jesus. In our daily lives we all too often like to do it our own way and miss out on the comfort and power that comes from a healthy dependence on God. May we trust in the grace and goodness of God.



- develop ways to encourage & enable Aboriginal people to serve & lead in all aspects of LCA church life.



Philip Yancey probes the very heartbeat--the most fundamental, challenging, perplexing, and deeply rewarding aspect--of our relationship with God: prayer.

What is prayer? Does it change God's mind or ours--or both? This book is an invitation to communicate with God the Father who invites us into an eternal partnership through prayer.

I wrote Prayer: Does It Make Any Difference? because I felt so bad about my prayer life. Surveys show that the vast majority of people pray at least sometimes. Yet if you're like me, when you read books on prayer you end up feeling guilty and inferior. Few people I've talked to experience satisfaction in prayer.

I write books about questions I don't know the answer to, issues that are still unresolved for me. And I've waited a long time to tackle this subject of prayer, mainly because I didn't know what to say.
