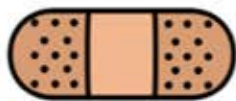


Eggs are a healthy food because they are full of vitamins and minerals. Help your grown up cook an egg for your lunch. Delicious!

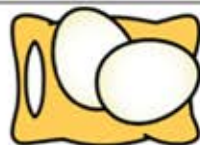
*Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall.
