Finding Courage

'Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit looked up to heaven and saw the glory of God and Jesus standing at the right hand of God.'

Acts 7:55

When our youngest daughter was just starting to walk she was very cautious when she came near anything on the ground. If the floor changed from tiles to carpet, she would freeze and call out for us. There was a covered drain at the side of our house and, again, when she approached it, she would freeze and call for mum or dad. Once she had one of us next to her she was a different person! She boldly took the next steps on her adventure.

Just as our daughter found courage to face the unknown when mum or dad was next to her, so the first martyr, Stephen, showed incredible courage because the Lord was with him as he faced a hostile crowd. We often feel weak and lacking courage when we confront challenges on our own. Despite our best efforts to 'dig deep' and 'be brave', it's hard to muster courage in our own strength. That's why the story of Stephen is so inspiring. We see that Stephen was filled with the Holy Spirit and he had a window into the eternal as he faced those who persecuted him. Our God never left him alone. And with God alongside, Stephen showed amazing courage.

We too face the challenges of life with God alongside us. The bible says that God is on our side and his presence is always with us. We can turn to him to find courage and hope anytime. With God in our corner it is amazing what we can overcome.

This week we and the teachers are preparing and hopely next week the students will come in for term 2.


Next week Sunday we will have installation service which was delayed because of the vacancy in the Chaplin's position.

Members, friends and contacts of the LCA are invited to participate in ALC's firstever online short course, *Introducing the Psalms*. Led by Old Testament lecturer, LCA pastor and author, Rev Dr Adam Hensley, this three-part series of live online sessions is available without cost to anyone who can access the internet. In the Psalms we can hear our own voice and God's reply. They take us through journeys from the depths of despair to seasons of celebration and thankfulness. If you are missing exploring God's word with members of your local community, then why not become part of ours? Neither age, background, location nor previous education matter—anyone who is interested in learning more about the diverse genres of the Psalms, their origin and importance in the worship life of Israel and their significance for biblical faith, is invited and encouraged to register.
