Play



Hide and seek is so much fun. Pretend to be a little mouse and hide while your grown up counts to 10. Don't forget to be quiet like a mouse.

Rhyme

The clock struck one.
The mouse ran down.

Paint



The face of a clock is a circle. Gather different size cups and some paint. Dip the rim of the cup into the paint and print onto paper. You will have lots of little circles to decorate.

Move



Use your body to act out Hickory Dickory Dock. Use your arms to make the clock movement. Clap your hands to make the clock strike "one."

Build



Build your own grandfather clock tower. Use blocks to see how big you can make your clock. Would a mouse be able to run up your clock without knocking it down?
