

The Holy Trinity

The final thing Jesus said to his disciples was 'Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,' (Matthew 28:19). This expression has been used for centuries as the people of God receive the gift of Holy Baptism. What it means is that the fullness of God is active in our Christian life. We are reconciled to the Father



through the work of the Son by the power of the Holy Spirit. And in our daily life, we know the nature of God through the life of Jesus, we seek to do the will of the Father as we are guided by the Holy Spirit. As we grow in Christian maturity, we love each person of the Godhead more deeply.

There are many analogies that have been used to describe how God can be one God in three persons but it should not surprise us that the exact understanding of God's being is beyond us. We simply cannot imagine something that is so utterly beyond our experience. However, as we grow in faith we see that the mystery of the Holy Trinity is something to celebrate.

The doctrine of the Holy Trinity came from the church's declaration that Jesus is God. This is important because only God can cleanse us from all sin and make us holy by his action alone. In the action of Jesus, we have salvation. In the work of the Spirit we have faith in Jesus so that we are joined with the Father, to do his will. May the Triune God keep us close.
