Defibrillator and First Aid Training

Everyone is encouraged to attend one of the sessions. The first aid-trained volunteers in our congregation should definitely attend. In line with current restrictions, each session is limited to 20 people - *please register via the link below*.

We will also be arranging a <u>Basic Emergency Life Support course</u> in the coming weeks, to be held at GGLC. The course is a combination of online learning and face to face assessment, covering:

- CPR for adults and infants, plus use of an defibrillator
- Breathing difficulties Asthma use of puffer and spacer

at the following times:

- Anaphylaxis (allergic reaction)- use of an EpiPen
- Choking with airway obstruction back blows and chest thrusts
- Unconscious casualty recovery position
- Bleeding and shock bandaging



If you wish to do a full first aid course, the separate defibrillator training with Jacquie will not be necessary (unless you would like to cover it twice!).

As we hold various programs and events across all ages and with varying degrees of risk, it is important that we have first aid trained volunteers and staff available to support these events. The above course will be made available to all volunteers and staff at no cost; for anyone else who wishes to attend, subject to availability, the cost is \$69. We are currently looking for expressions of interest in the first aid course, and will set a date and time based on the responses received. SYNOD CONVENTION UPDATE No.3

The **49**th **Synod Convention** was to be held in May, but due to the Covid 19 this did not happen. The delegate (Rosalie Hoklas) received the **Book of Reports** and will cover a few points of interest raised.

This is the third update.

It is important that we as a congregation know what happens within our wider SA & NT church community and continue to pray for our leaders.

The theme for synod was "The Hope we Have" 1 Peter 3:15.

Listed are a couple of points from the Book of Reports

** Assistant Bishop for Mission- Pastor Stephen Schultz

I see it as a priority to resource, encourage and focus the communities of the District, in accordance with the mission statement of the District. In order to do this I have seen it as essential to be present on the ground in the communities of the District. This includes congregations, schools, aged care facilities, District camps and other organisations in the District (e.g. Lutheran Community Care). I engaged congregations/parishes through preaching and leading worship and attendance at council, congregational and fraternal meetings. I have conducted congregational/regional workshops at many different locations. I attend AbMinSA meetings held on a bi-monthly basis to conduct oversight of this ministry area. Together with Stuart Traeger from Lutheran Education (LESNW) we have visited more than 20 school communities to engage in a conversation with the principal/pastor about their partnership in ministry & mission. These have been valuable visits and we are encouraged by the quality of leaders we have in our schools. We have identified the need to foster the relationship between congregations and schools and to help congregations in their ministry-mission in the school environment.

The Children, Family, Youth and Young Adult ministry area (Blueprint) now comes under my oversight with the District ministry re-structure. My role is demanding and multi-faceted. That said, I have been energised by the role and feel a strong sense of call and commitment to it.

You truly are salt and light in so many ways and I am deeply encouraged and humbled by the way I have seen you serve – often in difficult circumstances. I have an unwavering belief in our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. He is leading our Lutheran Church. He is truly present with us and is blessing us with everything we need to be the church in our local communities. May he bring you joy as you continue to serve him and his people.




UPCOMING CAFÉ TRAINING
