Genesis 12:1-3



Asaroka Update



Greetings from family here at Asaroka PNG to you, and the Golden Grove congregation. Thank you very much for your prayers.

Asaroka is slowly going back to normal after the SOE have been lifted by the government. Teachers are working really hard for the hours lost due to the Covid 19 lock down. Few things from this end;

- 1. Head Stone or Monument project for late Rev Tscharke which was prolonged due to Covid 19 is now beginning to progress this week. As soon as its done will remind you for the unveiling.
- 2. The school management, under the leadership of Mr. Aki Olisagave, made a new deal with Telikom PNG to reconnect the internet access. The computers in the Staff room and few in the computer lab are hooked up and we are enjoying the internet service for the first time beginning this week Monday (15/06/20). The school will pay K1000 every month for unlimited internet service here in the school.
- 3. Asaroka farm is also resurrected. Rice planting and other food crops are also planted. Eastern Highlands Provincial administration is interested in the vast agricultural potential here at Asaroka Lutheran Secondary School. We continue to pray that they will also invest here.
- 4. The single classroom beside the dinning hall will be demolished starting next Monday to put up a new four-inone classroom. It is funded by the Eastern Highlands Provincial Administration. The Correctional Service in Bituhe will be engaged to build the new four-in-one classroom. Praise God for all this things happening here.
- 5. The new Chaplin is settling well and putting the spiritual program in place now so please continue to pray for him because this is his first time in Chaplaincy duties although he involved in pastoral duties especially in churches.


