Being Tested

School exams are not set to make us fail though it may feel like that, instead they give an opportunity to prove what we know. None of us likes exams and none of us likes or would choose to face trials in our lives. Perhaps this helps us understand what is going on in the strange story of Abraham's call to sacrifice Isaac.

Abraham was given a task beyond human understanding and he had to resolve for himself how this task could be achieved because it went against every promise God had made and all he knew of God's character. He could choose to reason around the issue or he could trust and comply. Isaac too, now a young man, surely with more strength than his aged father, could have resisted or run away but instead we see him passively

accepting his father's instruction, trusting his love and that of his father's God. God proved the gold of their faith through this test.

When trials come our way, as they surely do, they are opportunities to prove the promises of God. The whole Bible attests that God is always good, righteous, fair, just, loving and full of mercy, that He has plans to prosper us. When we are in the midst of trials, acutely aware of our own weakness or lack of understanding, of fears or doubts, God's promises are still relevant, His character, still true and we can cling to both. God's working might not equal our immediate hopes but will benefit in time and eternity. Through every test, the God of our faith will be revealed and faith proved as precious metal.

Lord when we must face trials help us not to be overcome, but to trust You. Prove Your promises to us, that faith may grow and then in the next testing time we will be sure that, "The Lord provides". In Jesus Name. Margey Knapp Amen.

Meals Ministry / Freezer


Can you help please! We are seeking meals for the freezer in the Fellowship kitchen to help support families in times of need. If

Free online short course opportunity: The Gospel of Mark



Following the success of ALC's first ever online short course in May, ALC is offering a second online short course in July on the Gospel of Mark.

Led by New Testament senior lecturer Dr Stephen Hultgren, this series engages participants in the world of Mark. Commencing 9 July, three sessions will be held over 3 consecutive Thursdays from 1.30–2.30 pm CST (2–3 pm EST):

- Out of the shadows: appreciating the Gospel of Mark
- Who is Jesus? The beginning, the middle, and the end of Mark's story
- Taking up the cross: discipleship according to Mark

The sessions are accessed via a Zoom link and are live. There are no barriers to participation based on age, location or education level; anyone who can receive an email can join in. Participation can be active or passive—it's your choice.

First Aid Training

IT IS NOT TOO LATE TO REGISTER AN EXPRESSION OF INTEREST!!

We will be arranging a <u>Basic Emergency Life Support course</u> in the coming weeks, to be held at GGLC. The course is a combination of online learning and face to face assessment, covering:



- CPR for adults and infants, plus use of an defibrillator
- Breathing difficulties Asthma use of puffer and spacer
 - Anaphylaxis (allergic reaction)- use of an EpiPen
- Choking with airway obstruction back blows and chest thrusts
 - Unconscious casualty recovery position
 - Bleeding and shock bandaging

The above course will be made available to all **volunteers and staff at no cost**; for anyone else who wishes to attend, subject to availability, the cost is \$69.

We are currently looking for expressions of interest in the first aid course, and will set a date and time based on the responses received. Please register your interest at the link below to ensure that you receive follow-up information.
