The Parable of the Sower

Then he told them many things in parables, saying: “A farmer went out to sow his seed..”
Matthew 13:3

The parable of the sower is one of those stories that is so well known that we often skip over it thinking we know all there is to know about the farmer, the seed and the soil. However, Jesus words always bless us with more when we take time to meditate and apply His word. So too with this parable.

Usually we focus on the soil because this is what Jesus did when he explained this to the disciples. It is good for us to examine our hearts and see if we are receptive to God’s word and if we are soft enough of heart to allow that word to take root in our lives. It also helps us understand why there are so many different responses to God’s invitation around us and to appreciate that each one of us can change from hard soil to good, or from productive soil to soil that just has latent potential. We all travel our own faith path and it is never straight.

We can also see this parable with us as the farmer. We are charged with the responsibility to sow the seeds of God’s Kingdom wherever we are situated. It is both exciting to know that some of what we sow will manifest a great harvest and comforting to know that much of our ‘sowing’ will fail to take root. We should not be discouraged by an apparent lack of success. Our call is to be faithful to God’s word and speak his word. We will also be amazed at what results do materialize.


