### **Prayer Starts With God**

He said to them, "When you pray, say: "Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come.

Luke 11:2

Prayer is about living a relationship. It is our intimate and ritual communication with God. Just like any relationship prospers are withers on the quality of the communication, so too our relationship with God will be close or not so close depending on the state of our prayer life.

Just like any relationship, sometimes communication comes easy and things are wonderful. Other times, however, communication can be difficult and we can feel that there is a problem that needs to be addressed.

The bible gives us much insight into healthy relationships. Repeatedly we are encouraged to put the other person's needs before our own and look for ways to serve them. When life partners live for the good of the other, the strength of their relationship is obvious. When friends actively seek the love in the fellowship together rather than the activity they share, life-long bonds are made. So it is with our relationship with God; it begins with us looking to glorify and serve him. It is strengthened by our desire to simply be in his presence no matter what we are doing.

In the Lord's Prayer we see that Jesus focusses attention to God the Father in the very first petition. Of course God wants to know our hurts, our joys and our desires. But he craves a relationship where we delight in being with him. We begin our prayers with our attention on God just as his attention is always on us.

"War Room" Movie Review

WAR ROOM is a movie with an important message for all families who live in today's society, where the focus is on 'self' – having a successful job, large house, the latest model car and gaining as many possessions as possible to make us 'happy'.

Tony and Elizabeth are an American couple who appear to have it all. However, when you look closely, their relationship with one another and their daughter is broken and falling apart.

Elizabeth, a real estate agent meets a new client, Miss Clara who helps her see how negative and bitter she has become and Miss Clara strongly encourages her to pray and ask God for help to save her relationship with her family.

God works through Miss Clara so that Elizabeth comes to realise that she needs a relationship with Jesus in order to 'fix' her family relationships. She learns from Miss Clara about a War Room, a place to pray and meditate to God. Elizabeth sets up a War Room in her home where she can read God's Word and pray without distractions. On the wall, she pins prayer requests and Bible verses such as 2 Thessalonians 3:3 "But the Lord is faithful and he will strengthen you and guard you from the evil one."

Elizabeth's daughter, Danielle notices a change in her mother. Danielle adds her prayer list to the wall. As you watch this movie, it is awe-inspiring to witness the transformation in each member of this family as they shift their focus from 'self' to 'JESUS'. It demonstrates how prayer is a powerful weapon and that we too need to fix our eyes on Jesus and trust Him every day.
