Office of the Prime Minister & other representatives from the province & the district turned up to witness the launching. The Head Bishop of ELCPNG was also present. Government representatives said Asaroka has the potential to raise millions of kina if they seriously take the rice business. It is also a pilot project for schools in the province as well as the nation to venture into such an agricultural program. The government official assured Asaroka Rice Farming their support in finance or technical.


