### **Receiving Joy**

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Philippians 4:4-5

Some people make you feel great when they are around. Maybe it's their smile or because they're attentive or it might be something that's hard to define. Whatever the reason, there are those who just make our life more pleasurable when they're around.

In Paul's letter to the Philippians, he talks about receiving joy. According to Paul, rejoicing has everything to do with being 'in the Lord'. What's more, Paul goes

on to say that we are full of joy because the Lord is near. We see a very clear connection between the presence of God and our experience of joy. The closer we are to God, the more we know joy. Even when we go through the regular ups and downs of life, the joy that comes from God remains while we are close to him.

Conversely, we often forfeit joy that is rightfully ours when we neglect our relationship with God. Investing in a deep relationship with our Lord means that we know his presence even in the toughest times and we are assured of his attention to our situation. It's in this way that anxiety recedes and the joy of the Lord fills us. May we rest in him for our joy.







