The New Covenant

I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. Jeremiah 31:33

I have always been nervous signing contracts. It all stems from my first experience with a car dealer when I was 20. I wandered in to look at the lovely new cars and left with a contract to purchase a new car! The impact of that contract lasted for years as I paid the car off. I learned to be cautious when making

significant commitments and to make sure I was able to comfortably keep my side of the bargain.

God's covenant with his people was straightforward. He would provide them with land, prosperity and security as long as they stayed faithful to him. God knew that it would be difficult with so many other 'gods' vying for Israel's affection. In his mercy, God provided a way for them to be in good standing by instituting the sacrificial system that atoned for unfaithfulness. Still, the people of God wandered away and refused to repent.

Rather than giving up on humanity God chose to renew his covenant. This new covenant would be different in that he would be the only one who made the promises. In Jesus' work on the cross sins are no longer a barrier to God and he send his Spirit to shape the heart of those who believe. We are beneficiaries of this new covenant. All he asks is that we trust in his and his word.






