Palm Sunday

The triumphal entry,' it is called. We have heard it told so often. John 12v12 says that the disciples didn't really understand what had happened until after Jesus was glorified. At the time they looked at things through the lens of Jewish history and expectation. Our perception too can be clouded. We see Jesus riding a donkey - because the scriptures foretold it, riding into

Jerusalem and happily accepting adulation from the crowd. We forget that minutes before He was looking over Jerusalem from the vantage point of the Mount of Olives and crying over its people who would not love Him. It was a bitter, sweet journey.

In today's second reading, his letter to the Philippians 2 v 5-11, Paul is able to give us the clearest understanding of Jesus. Paul and the other disciples having seen the Risen Lord, were given hindsight through the power of the Spirit to understand what had transpired and they were also given foresight to see what would still be.

Paul explains that Jesus was God, 'in human likeness,' yet He was the most humble of men. He was more humble than any human could ever be. He humbled Himself to become obedient to the demands of God that would see His life laid down and ours saved. He declares Jesus as the One at whose Name, 'every knee,' in all creation and 'every tongue,' of every person, would one day bow to and acknowledge as Saviour, the blessed One, the true King of Israel. And, in that confession, somehow God would be glorified. May we too give God much honour and glory as we recognise that it is our God on that donkey, coming in love with intent to do everything possible to make us His own, eternally.

Lord Your grace, love and purpose astound us. May we live humbly before You our God and Saviour. Amen.

until the end of 2022, meeting fortnightly in term time. Please let Pastor Greg know if you wish to enroll.





When we literally or figuratively hold on to the cross of Jesus. we trust that he hears us and will be with us. Sometimes it is enough to hold the cross silently-this is

itself prayer. Trusting in the cross and what it meansforgiveness and life forever with Jesus-we can sincerely pray, both for ourselves and others.
