Being Generous

'All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had. Acts 4:32

Australians are known for their generosity. Whenever there is a crisis or disaster, most people will donate to assist those affected if not roll up their sleeves and provide physical help. Being part of the 'lucky country' means that most people have been blessed sufficiently to share a little with those who are doing it tough. Many of the things that are cherished in Australia, such as Medicare, seek to provide equality of

outcome in important areas of life.

The community of the disciples after the resurrection was the epitome of generosity. For the followers of Jesus, all things were gifts from God to be used for his purpose and the welfare of others. Private property wasn't hoarded or even desired, rather mission, faith and love were sought. This type of generosity is unusual as it means that each person needs to trust others completely and trust the providence of God. What we see in the early church is the generosity and sacrifice of the disciples bearing much fruit and the kingdom of God thriving.

It is hard to imagine any group of believers living together and sharing all their possessions these days. But we can be inspired by the faith and obedience of the first disciples and learn from their willingness to trust one another and to trust God. Being generous is a testament to God's generosity.





Friends of Lutheran Archives

An outdoor gathering at Ebenezer SA, 21 March 1921: a milestone in the story of Lutherans in Australia.

Battered by years of oppression, Lutherans in Australia emerged from World War I feeling discredited, defenceless and disunited, but also with the conviction that God had been with them in their adversity and was now calling them to overcome their internal differences and seek to become one church under the Southern Cross, united in faith and life and mission. This presentation explores the story of the formation of the United Evangelical Lutheran Church in Australia 100 hundred years ago, focussing in particular on major factors leading to the union of 1921 that was a major milestone on the long path to the eventual union of almost all Australian Lutherans in one church body in 1966. Dr Dean Zweck will be the guest speaker at Friends of Lutheran Archives (FoLA) Monday 19th April, 7.30 pm at Bethlehem House in the city.

Holding Cross

A holding cross is also sometimes called a pocket cross, comfort cross, or caring cross. These small crosses are designed to fit comfortably into the palm of your hand as

a tactile aid to prayer. Use it as a spiritual companion for

easing children's fears, to comfort worries and stresses of adults and to focus the prayer of the sick and elderly. When we

literally or figuratively hold on to the cross of Jesus, we trust that he hears us and will be with us. Sometimes it is enough to hold the cross

silently—this is itself prayer. Trusting in the cross and what it means—forgiveness and life forever with Jesus—we can sincerely pray, both for ourselves and others.
