We are the branches

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing".

John 15:5

These words of Jesus are very special to our Golden Grove community. You can see these words on signs or letterheads and even our logo echoes the idea that we are connected to Jesus as the true vine. While Jesus was using an image well recognizable in the first century to illustrate some deep truths, we 'get it' as well some 2,000 years later. Such is the brilliance of our Lord; his words are eternal.

We can be connected to people in any number of ways. We are biologically connected with our families, we are vocationally connected with our work mates and we are emotionally connected with our friends. When Jesus talks about us being connected to him as a branch is attached to a vine, he is talking about a much deeper relationship. Jesus asks us to remain or abide in him. The original language speaks of a permanency of dwelling. We see a connection that solid and alive.

That is both the call and the blessing of our Christian life. As we remain in Jesus we have the security of a relationship that will not falter or disappoint. Despite being so permanent, our relationship with Jesus is alive and changing as we experience changing seasons in our lives. The life-blood of the Holy Spirit pumps through our soul as we stay attached to Jesus, the true vine.
