There can be some confusion when it come to understanding our interaction with the Holy Spirit of God. Some say that being filled with the Holy Spirit is accompanied by super-natural abilities right away, such as speaking in tongues or performing miracles. Others claim that when the Holy Spirit is present there is a physical or emotional experience that is a gift from God. Still others say that the Holy Spirit is the 'quiet achiever', acting in our own spirit by guiding our conscience and creating faith.

According to the bible, all of these things are signs of the Holy Spirit. When we understand that the Holy Spirit is not a force or power but is a person then we see that the Spirit's actions will be different in varying circumstances and with different people. We only get confused when we try to make the Holy Spirit's movement prescriptive. There will be times when our encounter with the Spirit is predictable and almost routine. There will be other times when it will be unexpected and challenging. This is true for all relationships.

The common element right throughout scripture is that the Holy Spirit is intertwined with the Holy Word of God. We see in Acts, the Holy Spirit is given when the apostles are preaching God's Word. When Peter was talking to a crowd of non-Jewish people about Jesus the Holy Spirit came on them, just like it had to the Jewish people at Pentecost. May we receive God's Spirit as we live in the Word of God. *Pastor Greg*
