The Mystery of God's Kingdom

Again he said, "What shall we say the kingdom of God is like, or what parable shall we use to describe it? It is like a mustard seed, which is the smallest of all seeds on earth. Yet when planted, it grows and becomes the largest of all garden plants, with such big branches that the birds can perch in its shade."

Mark 4:30-32

There are many mysteries in our world. Even though we have studied seeds and know the mechanics of a seed becomes a plant, the essence of the life force held in that seed

is still a beautiful wonder. Indeed all new life is a miracle even if we understand the process that underpins it.

God's Kingdom is similar. Every person who comes to faith in Jesus is a miracle. We may preach the gospel and we may serve those calls us to serve but how that translates into someone knowing Jesus intimately and living a new life is something only God knows. His Kingdom grows and is sustained by his Spirit. Just as the mustard seed appears small and uninspiring, we celebrate that God uses ordinary, and often uninspiring, people to bring his Kingdom.
