### Jesus meets our needs

When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things....Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke the loaves. Then he gave them to his disciples to distribute to the people. He also divided the two fish among them all. They all ate and were satisfied.

Mark 6:34-42

We all love the story of Jesus feeding the 5,000 (or more) people. The miracle of multiplying food is enthralling but the insight into God's character is enlightening. Jesus saw a crowd of people who were in desperate need both physically and spiritually. His parental heart moved him to do whatever was necessary to meet their needs.

We see Jesus' priorities clearly in this account. For our Lord, the greatest gift he could give was to teach them; after all he had the words of eternal life. He was also aware of their need for food. Jesus meets both of these

needs and the crowd were satisfied. I'm sure that satisfaction was more than simply physical. Jesus satisfied both their immediate hunger for food and the hunger of the soul that is only quenched by his presence. The scripture talks of Jesus having compassion for them. He felt their need and was moved to action.

Our God's character is always consistent. Jesus is the same today. He has compassion for all his people and is aware of our needs. The wonderful thing about Jesus is that he will ensure that all our needs are met. Our needs for close communion with him and to be part of his plan is just as essential for us as is physical food. May we acknowledge our need and receive his provision with gratitude.
