Making Wise Choices



Now, Lord my God, you have made your servant king in place of my father David. But I am only a little child and do not know how to carry out my duties. Your servant is here among the people you have chosen, a great people, too numerous to count or number. So give your servant a discerning heart to govern your people and to distinguish between right and wrong. For who is able to govern this great people of yours?'

When Solomon ascended to the throne of Israel he knew that his main job was to make wise choices. Everyone would look to him to make decisions that would impact an individual right through to the whole nation. Solomon understood that the impact of any decision could be far-reaching and may well have unintended consequences. When he asked for wisdom above all else, God was so pleased he blessed him with fame and success as well as wisdom.

We too are called to make choices all the time. Some of them don't really make that much difference. 'what are we having for dinner?' is a different question to 'will this action strengthen my faith?'. Some of our decisions have

ongoing impacts in our life. In one way or another, we prioritise things through our choices all the time. Who we associate with, what interests take our time and how we serve in our vocation can define us. When we decide to allow God to guide our choices and invite him to be an active part of our life, we live as God's children, active in his family.
