God Does Not Discriminate



My brothers and sisters, believers in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ must not show favouritism. James 2:1

In theory everyone agrees that discrimination is bad. Nobody should be disadvantaged because they are in some way different to others. We have laws to prohibit discrimination which have been expanded as our society becomes more aware of latent discrimination. In practice, however, it is easy for us to categorise others, almost ranking people so that we know how to best relate to them.

God does not do that to his own creation. Every person is created in the image of God and therefore is both precious and worthy of respect. While we are born into sin, each human has the capacity to reflect something of God to the world and thereby bless others. James forcefully instructs believers to not favour one person or group over another because lesus came to rescue all people; such was their value that he chose to die in their place.

When we find ourselves falling into the trap of discriminating against others it is good for us to have a little

spiritual check-up. Often our discrimination comes from either ignorance or our own insecurity. If someone is different to me and I don't understand their culture and norms I will naturally think they are inferior to me. Australia's record toward indigenous nations shows just that. Similarly, if I am insecure and fearful, I can lash out and try to pull down that which is different and potentially dangerous.



Our God asks us to look to him for wisdom, courage and understanding. As we are filled with his Spirit, we will display the same love and acceptance that our Lord shows to us. Pastor Greg
