Praying With The Right Motive

You desire but do not have, so you kill. You covet but you cannot get what you want, so you quarrel and fight. You do not have because you do not ask God. When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures. James 4:2-3

I am often guilty of praying with a list of needs that I believe I need to bring to God's attention so that he can do something to fix a problem or provide for someone in a particular way. Sometimes my prayers are for others and their needs and sometimes they are for myself. Sometimes they are focused on God's will and sometimes they are selfish. I am not all that different from anyone else.

This scripture reminds us that our prayers are not an opportunity for us to hook into a divine power just to make our lives easier. The point of prayer is the genuine, open communication with our Lord. Just like our

conversations with our family and friends are a blessing in themselves, so our times of prayer are likewise times to be savoured as we do nothing else but give God our full attention. Of course there will be times when we bring our needs to God; that's natural in an authentic relationship. But when the gifts become more important than the giver it's time to reassess our motives.
