Reformation

Today marks the anniversary of the Reformation, when a monk named Luther protested against practices that were not in the bible and set off a series of events that resulted in the creation of new Protestant churches. While the event is noteworthy, we don't acknowledge the anniversary because of its historic importance. Rather, we celebrate the anniversary of the Reformation because it draws us back to the central teaching of the bible: God is love and his love is shown through Jesus' work on the cross.

There are also key values that were rediscovered in the Reformation that we hold dear today. In Romans 3:23-24 Paul writes 'for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.' Because God freely gives his grace to us, we live grace and create grace places. Golden Grove Lutheran Community is a grace place. We never doubt God's love for everyone and

his unconditional offer of life with him, now and forever. As God forgives us and sees the best in us, so we forgive each other and see the best in each other. Because Jesus values every person so much that he gave his life for us, we value each person in our community as a unique creation of God. And as God's love and grace are for all, our community is one that includes everyone.

The LLL has announced the provision of LLL Bursary Grants from the commencement of the 2022 school year.

Believe. Collaborate. Achieve. The bursary grants are intended to be awarded for a maximum of six years but reviewed on an annual. They are prioritised to those

children entering the traditional primary and secondary intake years, that is, the first year of formal primary schooling or the first year of secondary school. The grants are to cover 50% of the annual tuition fee (exclusive of camps and levies) up to a maximum of \$5,000. Preference will also be given under the program to active communicant members of the LCA or another Christian denomination.
