Giving to God

A poor widow came and put in two very small copper coins, worth only a few cents. Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others. They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything—all she had to live on."

Mark 12:42-44

The story of the widow's offering is challenging for all of us. When we hear the account we just cannot identify with this woman who has so much faith in God's provision and so much love for him that she will give everything she has to the ministry of the temple. We, like most, give out of our wealth.

To keep things in perspective, Jesus is not condemning all the others; he is simply showing how God sees things. Giving for the Lord's work is a good thing. While everybody could plainly see the large donations, God's attention was drawn to the smallest of all; the one that was given from a love-filled heart. This is really what the story is about. God is ultimately concerned with our relationship with his. His desire is that we have deep love

for him and unshakable trust in him. When we see the widow, we are challenged to examine our love for God.

Of course we live by grace which means that Jesus does not turn away from us no matter our heart. His action is to walk with us, love and care for us, and wait for us to embrace him. His promise is not conditional. His love never fails.
