Pastor's Corner



- Today we are celebrating **Ascension Day** with the sermon theme: Jesus ascended, we have hope". Have you ever felt as though life is hopelessliterally hopeless? We'll hear a testimony from Obie about how hopeless her life was. Then we'll consider what I call the 7 aspects of Jesus' ascension. We'll look at least at a few of the ramifications of Jesus' ascension.
- Last week I introduced (again) the Hey, let's talk about the sermon! Why not use these few questions to think / talk about the sermon:
 - 1. Jesus' ascension means we don't see Jesus. Do you think it is important (for our hope) that we don't see Jesus?
 - 2. There are many promises (hopes) tied up in Jesus' ascension. What are most important ones for you? How do we treat this hope?
 - 3. One of the aspects of Jesus' ascension is to do with Jesus being in control, eg. in control over death, the Church, what is happening around us. Is it im portant to know Jesus is in fact in control? If he is in control, what then?
- Next week is the festival of Pentecost. We are celebrating the rite of **Next Step** (confirmation) when the "next steppers" will have opportunity to profess their faith: what we said on their behalf at their Baptism and then be blessed by God to live in that faith. The "next steppers" have been given the morning or evening service or at a later time.
- The **theme for next week's sermon** based on Deuteronomy 10:12f. is "What does the Lord require of you?"
- Congratulations to John Fielke, Wayne Evans and Malcolm Rogers who have organized "The Valiant Man" course which is being run these Thursday evenings in conjunction with Para Vista (on Wednesday evenings).
- Our congregation is sponsoring a table at the **National Day of Thanksgiving breakfast** this Saturday. It is one way we can say thank you to God and that we appreciate what particular people are doing for our community.


