ADVENT

"Advent Joy"

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. Philippians 4:4-6

In the weeks leading up to Christmas, I see quite different emotions in people. Some are beginning to get into the joyous mood of Christmas celebration while others are not feeling the joy at all. Certainly every one of us faces different situa-tions that affect our view of the run up to Christmas but how we choose to respond makes all the difference.

Christmas can be tough for lots of people. Those who have lost loved ones; those who are separated from family; those who have unhappy memories of Christmas' past and those struggling to make Christmas what they think it should be. The Apostle Paul knew about privations and struggles. His advice to the early Christians was to allow God into our situations rather than trying to shoulder the whole burden ourselves. We do this by praying with confidence that God is willing to hear our prayers and to

respond in a way that will be to our good. We also do this by seeing the blessings of God at work in the here and now.

In prayer and giving thanks we can recover the joy of the Christmas season, no matter our situation. Paul says emphatical-ly that this will lead to us rejoicing in the Lord. As we ponder God becoming human through the Christmas miracle, as we see him breaking into time and space, may we see him active in our lives.

Eating with others can be a profoundly spiritual act, when it is used as a way to express love through a focus on hospitality, community and mission.


