# 1st July 2007—5th Sunday after Pentecost

WELCOME to all worshipping with us today as we give thanks and celebrate the 20th Anniversary of GGLF.

### TWO MINUTES

"Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing. (John 15:5)

The Bible readings for today I believe were the ones picked for the first service of our congregation 20 years ago.

The first passage is Solomon's prayer in dedicating the temple. What he prays for the temple we could use for this place of worship today: May you watch over this Temple both day and night, this place where you have said you would put your name. May you always hear the prayers I make toward this place. May you hear the humble and earnest requests from me and your people Israel when we pray toward this place. Yes, hear us from heaven where you live, and when you hear, forgive. (1 Kings 8:29, 30). The second reading is what we used to look at our statement of mission, vision and core values last month, especially: But you

are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are a kingdom of priests, God's holy nation, his very own possession. This is so you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light. (1 Peter 2:9, 10) But arguably, the Gospel lesson (John 15:1-5) is the most profound, especially verse 5 (above).

Just think of it: we are connected to Jesus as intimately as branches are to a vine. We rely on him for sustenance, support and structure. Jesus is living within us. This image draws our minds to Holy Communion, the Spirit of Jesus living in our hearts and that we are His temple (See 1 Corinthians 6:19).

We need Him to produce fruit. If we haven't produced the fruit in keeping with repentance (Matthew 3:8 NIV), the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22, 23) in our lives, and if we haven't produced the fruit of evangelism from our lives- we must wonder if we are still grafted onto the vine.

The vine stock is hardy. I have noticed that we have built on a vineyard. The original grape vines are still shooting in our gardens if we haven't poisoned them. Jesus' relationship with us is hardy too. No matter how we have neglected him in the past, He still wants to restore a relationship with us - that is if we haven't poisoned it! And isn't that profound?

Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank you that you have grafted us onto yourself at our Baptism, for nourishing us through your Word and Sacramenthere at Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship over the past 20 years and that you produce fruit in our lives. Forgive us if we have poisoned our relationship with you in any way. Give us please a deeper intimacy with you as we more deeply appreciate that you are the vine and we are the branches. Amen. 


### SHOP FOR YOUR SCHOOL




### Lutheran Community Care
