The Resurrection of Jesus



Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures. I Corinthians 15:3-4

The Apostle Paul made a point of clearly, and unambiguously, stating the basis of our Christian belief to the Corinthian congregation. From the earliest times there have been believers in Jesus' message who had doubts about his bodily resurrection. It seems easier to think of lesus' resurrection as symbolic or 'spiritual' and those

theories have always been around. Paul could not be more forceful in his assertion that lesus was raised physically and interacted with many for weeks before he ascended into heaven.

Throughout the ages many people have been drawn to Jesus' message of love, grace and acceptance and his promise to be with us always. His word is living and transforms. God's Holy Spirit is at work, comforting and empowering those who accept the words of Jesus as well as creating faith and hope. For some, this is enough and the teaching that lesus was physically raised seems of little consequence. However, the scriptures tell us that the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit is only possible because of the real events of Easter.

Paul connects Jesus' actual resurrection to God's work for us throughout humanity. Jesus was raised 'according to the scriptures', and part of God's divine plan for us. Jesus' resurrection is just as real as our lives and our need for his salvation. Paul goes so far as to say that faith in Jesus is in vain if he was not physically resurrected.



We praise God that his Son died for our sins and was physically raise on the third day. Pastor Greg
