### Transformed Through Faith

The resurrection The Old Testament people thought Moses' face reflecting God's glory frightening and unbearable so in an act of grace, Moses covered his face.

Paul picks up and explains the veil and glory theme using the context of Easter. Easter changes everything. Old ways are ended as dramatically as the rending of the temple curtain, the symbolic veil between God and man.

Paul explains that we all live life through the veil of sin. We are naturally fearful and misunderstand everything about God, the world and ourselves until there is faith in the One who died for us. Jesus, with the power that raised Him from the dead, removes the veil

between Him and us and, forgiving sin, grants the gift of faith so we can know Jesus as Saviour.

In that gift our understanding is transformed. Jesus is no longer just another teacher, He is now our God

transfigured, our shining Saviour and personal Lord. And as we make that confession, by the grace of God's Spirit, the process of transformation begins in us and through His grace, we even reflect the image of Christ. Amazing.

Amazing God, Thank You for the gift of faith and a new way of living with nothing to separate us from Your love in Christ Jesus our Lord. Amen


