God's Invitation

"Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost. Isaiah 55: I

I always get excited when I receive an invitation to a special event, like a wedding or birthday. Almost always there is some type of party and an opportunity to spend leisurely time eating with others who are important to us. This is exactly what we see in the bible where God's invitation is for all.

Our God wants us to value him enough to put aside some time to connect with him without rushing. He wants us to relax in his presence and be open to listening and speaking words that give us fulfilment. He wants us to come to him with an understanding that he wants nothing from us; he chooses to provide all that we need. He knows that we have needs that can't be satisfied elsewhere and he is willing to attend to those needs.

The image of thirst is common in the bible. Partly because Israel is a dry place but more importantly the craving for water that accompanies thirst is a good metaphor for our need for God. When we have had an experience of God's presence, we will crave more. When we have seen our needs met by his hand, we want to be even closer to him as we trust that he will continue to sustain us. The drive that we have to satisfy thirst is stronger than just about anything else. This is the dynamic that Isaiah describes as we enjoy our God.

Wonderfully, God's invitation for us to be satisfied is not exclusive. He wants all people to know the exhilaration of life with God. As the world will deplete our resources and sometimes such us dry, God's presence renews and refreshes us. This lent may we lay aside those things that sap us and turn to God who fills us.
