The New Covenant

And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you."

Luke 22:19-20

So often we hear people say 'we need to celebrate the real meaning of Easter/Christmas' etc. This is a natural desire because we see the commercial and holiday aspects dominate our increasingly non-religious society. At Christmas, we want to focus on God entering our world to be with us and we don't mind talking about that because we can point to the happy story of a baby being born into a loving family and the joy that surrounds that event. Easter is more difficult because talk of sacrifice and death are uncomfortable. But without Easter, Christmas would be meaningless, so we are encouraged to speak the truth of God's love shown in Jesus on the cross.

Jesus himself told his disciples about his mission, his purpose and what it means for the whole world. He made it abundantly clear in his words and actions at the Last Supper. In fact, the events on the night he was betrayed provide interpretation for all that is to follow. It is no wonder the Maundy Thursday services are treasured by many disciples of Christ. Jesus said his blood would be poured out to create a new covenant that would supersede the covenant God had previously made with his people. The benefits of Jesus' death and resurrection would be available for free to any who choose to enter the covenant he makes.

God's actions for us are really beyond comprehension. Jesus defeated death on the cross. As Paul says, death has no sting; we continue to live beyond the grave. We are assured of life with God forever. We can also participate in the work of the Holy Spirit right now because Jesus broke all barriers between humans and God. Hallelujah! This was all Jesus' action alone, for us.

We access all of God's blessing, promise and presence through the new covenant. God binds himself to his word. He does not lie and he does not go back on his word. That's his part of the covenant. We enter the covenant by faith; we believe God's word and we act accordingly. Because we have unfettered access to God, we invite his presence each day. God's new covenant define our relationship with him. Let's celebrate it this Easter.

GGLC Young Adults



GGLC Young Adults provides a space for high school leavers, and young adults, to come together to grow in faith and fellowship. There are two primary events: our weekly Bible Studies lead by Pastor Greg and Noah Hahn, and our monthly Social Nights. These are held to provide an opportunity to invite anyone to come join in fellowship, and get a taste of the church community.

Bible Studies allow us to look at deeper issues that Young Adults are faced with everyday, whilst diving deep into the word. Some weeks Pastor Greg will get us talking about relationships, family, money, government, etc. At other time, Noah will lead through a guided Bible Study, looking currently at Galatians. The culture of the night also allows for people early in their faith journey to come and ask questions.

Social Nights are an easy-going stress-free environment to spend time meeting and eating with other young adults. These nights vary from a regular pub night, to most recently, a fun night full of ice-skating. The low pressure environment is perfect for inviting new or non-Christians to join in fellowship.
