The Ascension of Jesus

When he had led them out to the vicinity of Bethany, he lifted up his

hands and blessed them. While he was blessing them, he left them and was taken up into heaven. Then they worshiped him and returned to Jerusalem with great joy. Luke 24:50-52

After enjoying 40 days with Jesus post resurrection, His followers had to say goodbye again. They were together with him on the Mount of Olives, the place where He prayed in agony on His last night and the site of His arrest.

If there were any misgivings about the place, Jesus guides the disciple's thoughts to the future with the promise of baptism with the Holy Spirit. He instructed them to wait for it, then commissioning them He confirmed His call to be fishers of men, sending them to preach, teach and baptise in the Name of the Triune God. Then with the promise, "Surely I am with you always, to the end of the age", suddenly He ascends from the earth, rises to be hidden by clouds and is taken from their sight. With confirmation from Angels they went directly to the temple, trusting and praying.

Ascension is a little date on the calendar for most of us, falling on a weekday. However it is especially significant because of what is hidden from us - Jesus returning to heaven as God and now also as man. The whole of heaven celebrates the Coronation of Jesus, seated at God's right hand, receiving authority from God to send the Holy Spirit. It also marks the permanent positioning of His voice in the Father's ear, pleading forgiveness and mercy for those He loves and died for. He receives from His Father, Lordship over all things, so our salvation is eternally secure.

"Crown Him with many Crowns, the Lamb upon the throne."

Lord our Saviour King, praise, honour and glory are yours forevermore. Grant us understanding of Your Kingship that we may faithfully appreciate You more. Amen



GGLC Visiting Team

It's not always possible or practical for Pastor Greg to visit each member of the congregation and particularly during the COVID lockdowns it was impossible for him to contact everybody. It was at the first COVID lockdown that our Visiting Team was established (under the Pastoral Care Team) with the following people: Pastor Greg, Jack Ross, Judy Ross, Judith Whaites, Darryl Bischoff, Liz Shrowder & Dave Shrowder.

Each person was asked to contact the most vulnerable members to check if they were ok, or if they needed assistance with shopping, health/medical issues etc, and just to let them know we were thinking of them.

Most of you would be aware that each Sunday we mark off those members who are attending the service – not to check how often people attend but to be aware of when people are not there for several weeks in a row. Are they on a holiday, are they not well, has something happened that we should be aware of and be caring for them in some way? The Visiting Team are advised when such a situation might arise and will then follow up to ask if help is needed, and how we might provide it.

The Team meets regularly and recently allocated each member or family in the congregation to a Visiting Team member so that everybody in the congregation will be contacted at some stage through the year to ensure they are ok.


