Pentecost

They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

Acts 2:3-4

The promised advocate (Holy Spirit) came on the day of Pentecost and filled the disciples and continues to fill us today. The Holy Spirit enabled them (and us) to speak in tongues, heal the sick, to be equipped and continue to do the works of Jesus.

But what happened before this moment? Was the Holy Spirit around? We read in the Old Testament that the Spirit of God dwelled on people for a period, such as in 1 Samuel 16:13 where the Spirit came upon David as he was anointed.

So now when we pray for someone, we can pray with boldness and certainty that God will hear our prayer because he lives in each of us, and we are seated next to him in Heaven.

Lord, may we be open to your promptings for who you are calling us to minister to and where you are calling us to go in our lives. Amen

MONTHLY MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT

Prayer Healing

The Prayer Healing Ministry has been going for over 10 years. The main element of this ministry occurs on the first Sunday of the month at the Salt Factory Service. At this Prayer Healing Service, we have the opportunity to pray for a wide range of people, from words of encouragement, for people looking for a job, through to physical healing of their body & mind.

The Napier's have a weekly bible study on a Tuesday night and we have a monthly get together in the Barossa. Outside of the Sunday service we are now mainly praying for people over the phone but are more than willing to go to people's houses to pray.

The most wonderful thing is that praying for other people is not exclusive to a few people - you don't need to have any special talent for example like a musician has. All we need is a desire to learn from the bible to follow the examples of Jesus and the disciples on how they healed people. What we found is that it's actually very straight forward.

"But Peter said, "I don't have any silver or gold, but I do have something else I can give you. By the power of Jesus Christ from Nazareth, stand up and walk!" Acts 3:6

Peter trusted in GOD. He saw how Jesus prayed for people and he replicated it.

Over the 10+ years we have also found that the more we step out like Peter and Trust in God and His Word, we are seeing more and more of God's handy work (miracles). People that have been advised by their Doctor that they can't do any more for them have found God was able to set them free from their affliction which has now changed their life forever.


