Our hope in Christ

Isaiah 11:6-9 In that day the wolf and the lamb will live together; the leopard and the goat will be at peace. Calves and yearlings will be safe among lions, and a little child will lead them all. The cattle will graze among bears. Cubs and calves will lie down together. And lions will eat grass as the livestock do. Babies will crawl safely among poisonous snakes. Yes, a little child will put its hand in a nest of deadly snakes and pull it out unharmed. Nothing will hurt or destroy in all my holy mountain. And as the waters fill the sea, so the earth will be filled with people who know the LORD.

The prophet Isaiah certainly gets our attention with this image of hope. There was a certain fulfillment of this when Jesus first came as was described in the previous verses but of course this will be completely fulfilled in the days when Jesus comes back in all his glory. Does it mean there will be animals in heaven? It's deeper than that question. This image gives us the feeling of peace, safety, rest and tranquility that we look forward to when Jesus takes us to himself in heaven.

But we also have a taste of that every time we worship. I pray that you might have a taste of that today in worship.

One more thing, I spoke about God getting our attention as he did through Isaiah's prophesy here. These Sundays I am preaching about how we count down to Christmas: be ready, this morning - be repentant, next week - be open and finally be amazed. In regard to this morning's address God has to get our attention before he can lead us to being repentant. May he get your attention this morning too.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, please get our attention today that we may hear what you have to say to us. Please give us the peace and safety that comes from being in your presence today that we may have a foretaste of heaven. Thank you for the hope that we have in you. Amen. **Pastor Leon**

Pastor's Corner



- The most appropriate way to **come into God's presence** is on our knees. As we approach "Jesus' coming" (Advent), John the Baptist calls us to be repentant. He says in Matthew 3:2: *"Turn from your sins and turn to God, because the Kingdom of Heaven is near.*" We shall consider what it is to be repentant this morning in the address. John's approach was to get people's attention, hit them between the eyes, and calling for a change. We'll see that this can only be done properly though the power of the Holy Spirit. I am deliberately not using powerpoint in my address this morning to see what impact this has.
- This morning we are trialing something new: a sugges tion put to the worship team, that those people who come forward during Holy Communion distribution for a blessing will also receive a sticker/ tract/stamp.
- I hope that we can use the **Visual Bible** again for the Gospel reading. What do you think of this alternative to a reader?
- Welcome to **Poppy Jane Wilson** into God's family through Holy Baptism this morning.
- In confirmation this afternoon we are continuing to look at Luther and what it means to be Lutheran and hopefully consider the topic of "Pure grace"
- Keep on praying for our Youth Team Leader. The applications close this Tuesday and we have a meeting on Wednesday to decide where we go from here.
- Next Sunday Celina and Chantel from our school community will be **baptized** at our morning service.
- Are you looking for copies of this morning's address. They are available in the Fellowship Centre. I prefer people don't look at them before the sermon is given and we thought they would be more available to people if they were in the Fellowship Centre.
- **Please Note:** We shall be decking the Christmas Tree after the morning worship on 23rd December. I hope you can join in.
