TWO MINUTES

Matthew 11

⁷As John's disciples were leaving, Jesus began to speak to the crowd about John: "What did you go out into the desert to see? A reed swayed by the wind? ⁸If not, what did you go out to see? A man dressed in fine clothes? No, those who wear fine clothes are in kings' palaces. ⁹Then what did you go out to see? A prophet? Yes, I tell you, and more than a prophet. ¹⁰This is the one about whom it is written:

" 'I will send my messenger ahead of you,

who will prepare your way before you.¹¹ tell you the truth: Among those born of women there has not risen anyone greater than John the Baptist; yet he who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.

Our human nature is to judge people. It's very easy to try and justify that we are somehow better than another person based on certain criteria, whether it be appearance, wealth, or ability.

How do we compare to the Lord? We were made in his image, so immediately we fall short of his perfection. Luckily, he does not need to judge us on our appearance or ability because he created us. And why should wealth matter when everything belongs to him? The Lord looks into our hearts.

Jesus reminds the crowd here of how the Lord uses ordinary people to do his work. John was not rich or good looking, yet people would journey out from the city to listen to him speak. John was given special authority from the Lord, but Jesus makes it clear that there is different judgement in the kingdom of heaven; "yet he who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he".

Prayer: Lord of all power and wisdom, thank you for sending your son to wash away our sin so we can be seen fit to enter your kingdom. Help us to have a servant heart towards others instead of always thinking about ourselves. Amen.


For members who already use the REG system for giving please consider using a specially printed card (available from the entrance table in Church Foyer) to place in the offering plate rather than taking a set of envelopes.
