## Pastor's Corner



- Whether you are reading this at the beginning of our Easter journey on Maundy Thursday or part way through Easter: Good Friday or Holy Saturday or at the climax on Easter itself, I pray that you have a blessed Easter celebration.
- Over Easter our theme is Care:
- O Maundy Thursday: "Care for our community",
- O Good Friday: "Care for ourselves",
- O Easter dawn service: "Care early in the morning";
- O Easter: "Care for wider community".
- **Pigeon holes**. Please care for our community by having a look in your neighbour's pigeon hole and if they are rather full, use this opportunity to visit that family and take their "mail" to them. The Pastoral Carers have done this recently for some families. Next Week we intend to mail out those who haven't emptied their pigeon holes for a while.
- **Maundy Thursday** will feature the footwashing and the institution of Holy Communion.
- **Good Friday** will feature the "The Gospel of John" DVD to present the Gospel reading and something special to show us how special we are. God willing we shall be welcoming 5 new people into our membership next Friday morning.
- **Easter dawn service** 6.15am at : "*Wirrimbirra*" (Schmoker's block at the end of Grenfell road). Directions: second entry on the left, up the dirt track extension of Grenfell Road, Lot 65. There will be hot cross buns after this half hour service which will feature some well know Easter hymns and the Hallelujah chorus.
- Prior to the Easter service: hot cross buns at 8.45am. Main service with HC at the normal time 9.30am.
- Remember NO Salt Factory on Sunday evening.
- As I announced last week: The School/ Church picnic planned for next Sunday has been CANCELLED. Worship here at 9.30am- when we shall continue our Easter celebration of care.
- Remember too: copies of the 7 sermons in the Lenten sermon series:
   "Lord, teach us how to live" are available at the door this morning or the front desk (church admin.) during the week.
- Again I need to promote the welcome sheets. Please fill them in during the service.
- In relation to the Welcome Sheets, the Ministry Team is planning to offer a SERIES OF ELECTIVES on the Wednesday evenings in May: a three week series on Spirituality, Parenting and Relationships. (The thought is that you choose one of these electives and attend the 3 sessions on that particular elective). Thank you for those who have indicated on the Welcome Sheets which elective you would like to take up. If you haven't done so, could you please indicate on the Welcome Sheet today that you are, by writing "Elective YES" and either "Spirituality", "Parenting" or "Relationships".
- No **confirmation** today. Next week we are meeting to go to a cemetery to have the session on death and dying there.
- This week: **School Council** looking at our statement of mission, vision and values: Tuesday, meeting at 6.30pm.
- Here's an idea: the position of "Foster Grandparent": people who have volunteered to be available for parents with (small) children so they can look after the children (during the sermon) to enable the parents to have a better chance to not be distracted during our worship. It is happening already. But having this "position" would make this ministry available to more parents. Perhaps a badge could let new families know that this is available to them. What do you think?
- In this season of Easter the first readings are from "Acts". This book: "The Acts of the Apostles" is better named: "The Acts of the Holy Spirit" or "The Acts of the Living Lord" and we'll be looking at how we can care for the community by *living with the Lord*. So starting this Sunday we shall be open ourselves to God speaking in the sermon through the Book of Acts. Why not prepare for each Sunday by reading at least the first reading of the day: 30/3/08 Acts 2:14, 22-32; 6/4/08 Acts 2:14a, 36-41; 13/4 Acts 2:42-47; 20/4/08 Acts 7:55-60; 27/4/08 Acts 17:22-31; 4/5/08 Acts 1:6-14.


