TWO MINUTES

Jesus mothers us

That evening on the first day of the week, the disciples were meeting behind locked doors because they were afraid of the Jewish leaders. Suddenly, Jesus was standing there among them! "Peace be with you," he said. (John 20:19)...

This incident occurred on the first Easter night. The disciples were naturally terrified because of what had happened over the previous few days and were hiding together when Jesus appeared to them to show them that he was indeed alive.

I see many attributes of a good mother in Jesus' action: He was so close. Later he breathed on them - he was so close he could do that. He comforted them - when he could have disciplined them. "Peace be with you", he said. He expressed his feelings to them and it was contagious: They were filled with joy. He gave them what they needed: peace, the demonstration that he was alive and the Holy Spirit himself. Like a mother to her children - he spoke with authority: "I send you"..."If you forgive anyone's sins they are forgiven...". I see these as attributes of a mother but they are really expressions of love. (We'll see the Holy Spirit showing the attributes of a mother in the address this morning, which again are expressions of love.)

Don't we need the same love? : Jesus so close, Jesus comforting us, Jesus so real. Jesus giving us what we need, Jesus speaking to us with authority (to give us authority).

May you accept Jesus mothering you this morning.

Prayer: Lord Jesus thank you that you are a mother to us. Thank you that you are willing to be so close to us, comfort us, be real with us, give us what we need and speak with authority to us. Open our hearts that we may accept what you are so willing to give to us - your love. Amen.

- A **blessed Pentecost** and a **Happy Mother's Day** to you. I don't know how often Pentecost and mother's day would fall on the same day but we are going to use this opportunity of them falling on the same day to have a look at the theme: **Our Mother the Holy Spirit**, based on the first reading for today (Acts 2:1 f.) as well as other.

- From our AGMs last week: our congregation has passed the new constitution, agreed to be incorporated and Daryl reported we have a great tone to the school.
- **This week:** Management team: Tuesday. I will be away at Pastor's Conference from Wednesday through to Friday.
- **Next Sunday** we are celebrating confirmation. The theme is "Are you prepared to be blessed?" and text is 1 Samuel 9, 10. Four young people will be confirmed in the morning: Caitlin Andrejic, Darian Abraham, Nicole Fielke, Lachlan Ahrens and eight at Salt Factory: Matthew Christensen, Madalene DeVizio, Brodie Evans-Jachmann, James Norrey, Chris Rutter, Mark Schmocker, Daniel and Jessica Ward. Please pray for these young people as they prepare to be confirmed.
- From the **Confirmation 2008/2009** meeting last week we determined that the course will start at the beginning of third term, with Alyssa taking the first sessions, having the character of the 2007/008 course which was meetings, camps and field trips, but with the aspect of service included. We start on 22/7/08 at 4pm in the Fellowship Centre. (The time may change after the first session. The date of confirmation service being late February 2009 (possibly 22/2/09)
