Faith, Hope and Love

Genesis 12:1-9, Romans 4:13-25 & Matthew 9:9-13, 18-26

Where do you go when you're hurting?

In all of the readings this week, people were in what seemed hopeless situations – Abraham and Sarai were old and childless; the woman who had been bleeding for years had spent all she had on a cure; and Jairus' daughter was dead. Did they give up? No. Did they want to give up? Probably.

"Against all hope, Abraham...believed. (He) did not waver through unbelief, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God, being fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised." (Romans 4: 18-20) Give glory to God when you're hurting?

This is the stuff miracles are made of. This is where God's gifts of faith, hope and love come in – not from the strength within us, or that we'll find in the wilderness, or in trite words of comfort, in addictions, busy-ness or avoidance. But from God Himself.

God is the one who knows our pain – and gives us **hope**.

When all seems hopeless, God strengthens our faith.

And when it feels like we are breaking, He holds us together with His love.

Three little words – Three almighty gifts to us from our Creator, our Saviour, our Friend.
