TWO MINUTES

The story of God's grace and mercy in the face of deserved judgement, condemnation and death shines through our readings today. In Genesis we read of the groaning and suffering of the land as a consequence of man's sin. A hard, unyielding, cursed land that produces thorns and thistles *and yet* nourishing plants to provide us with sustenance for our daily living. Cain was driven from his land after killing his brother *and yet* given a mark that would spare him from a similar fate. In Matthew we are reminded that Jonah spent three days and nights in the belly of a fish (after disobeying God's commands) *and yet* was spared. In Romans we read that we deserve death through Adam when he sinned and brought condemnation on us all *and yet* we are given life through Jesus Christ.

What we deserve is not what we get! We deserve storms, raging bushfires and endless darkness *and yet* are given rainbows, bud burst and sunrises.

Thanks be to God, our awesome God of grace and mercy, for His gift of salvation through our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen

Pastor's Column

Today we are celebrating **Land Sunday.** This is the second Sunday of "The Season of Creation". I am sure you will notice the visual display and the special order of service we are using. Thanks to all those who have put so much time and effort into this special service. The theme for the message this morning is the provocative call to "Get back to the Land". We'll see it's a call to get back to (an appreciation of) the Biblical lands, get back to our land and get back to the Land Giver Himself. You are welcome to use the Sermon Study Guide to get deeper into the message.

Today is also **LCA Sunday**: an opportunity to remember that we are part of a wider community: The Lutheran Church of Australia. We thank God for all that he is doing through being a larger community, which we couldn't do as one congregation, such as the training of ministers, a wider school system and our extensive mission work to Aboriginal people and overseas.

Another reminder about "**Become a Gideonite**". Its aim is to raise \$1500 to support the Finke River Mission. Have you in mind a group that could raise this money? In the letter which is in the foyer it suggested a Gideonite could take any shape or form, "for instance...an individual, a prayer group, a Bible Study group, a youth group, a men's group, a woman's group, a congregation... a school...". If you are challenged or would like to talk about this please see me.

In 10 days time (Wednesday 24th September) we are starting the **NETWORK course**. Anna presented this very well in the last Life in the Vine. Here are some snippets from that article:

I know the church needs **me**. Not because it needs people to fill positions within the organisation, but because I am important and an integral part of the body of Christ. I have a significant contribution to make. I have a ministry in the church and a mission in the world.

Having said that, and knowing that each one of us has been equipped with special and specific spiritual gifts and abilities, how do we know what they are?

NETWORK is a dynamic 6 session process to help Christians understand who God has uniquely made them to be and guide them to a place of meaningful service in the local church. You may have participated in this programme in the past but revised and updated, the enormously popular Network approach has been refined for even greater effectiveness and ease of use.

Be sure to set aside each Wednesday evening in October and come and join me on our journey of self discovery. I've had a flip through the participants journal and it looks interesting and user friendly – a nice balance of scripture, sharing and reflection. Who knows what I'll discover about myself! Let's become the right people ... in the right place ... for the right reasons ... at the right time.

A couple of weeks ago we launched the **Church (TNIV) Bibles**. They are available in the worship centre. Please refer to the last 2 weeks Bulletins for an explanation.




