Pastor's Column

Today we are celebrating Outback Sunday, the third Sunday of "The Season of Creation". The theme for this morning's address is Struggle in the Outback. I will be considering that life can be an outback experience: a place of demons, to discover yourself and to get to know God Himself. You are welcome to use the Sermon Study Guide to get deeper into the message.

Have any of you or any groups you belong to taken up the challenge to "Become a Gideonite" (support the Finke River Mission. See the letter in the foyer)? Let me know.

The NETWORK course starts this WEDNESDAY. Are you interested? Enrol this morning. Here are a few thoughts from Daniel Dutschke about this course: I, like many people, have for a long time had a deep longing to know what God's plan for me was, as I have a very strong desire to serve my fellow man in some way that will make a difference. One of my biggest frustrations is not knowing what this plan was... So I was pleased when I had an opportunity to do the Network course a few years

The main objectives of the Network course are to help you to discover your Passion – Where you are best suited to serve, your Spiritual Gifts – what you will do when you serve and your Personal Style - how you will serve.... You won't necessarily walk out of the course with your eyes suddenly opened, but it is a mechanism to begin the process of discovery. What we found interesting was even in our small group, there was such a diversity in Passions, Spiritual Gifts and Personal Styles. It's God's plan that we are all different and can serve in different ways. ...

So what did I discover from the Network course? My Passion is to serve others in need by putting the right people in the right place to be of the best help to them. My Spiritual Gifts are Helping, Faith and Administration. My Personal Style is Task Orientated in a Flexible Unstructured Style. What's yours? I would sincerely encourage everyone of you to do the Network course... to find where you are best suited to serve both inside and outside the Church environment. You could be in an upfront role or in the background supporting- both are important. Timing also plays a role - don't be afraid to say yes, but not at the moment. Everybody's situation is different. Only you know what and how much you can offer. I know that I came away from the course with a clearer vision and goals. I pray that you will too. Don't forget to pray about it as well. The response may surprise you!

Are you interested in being involved in the Christian **Option** program- going into public schools to present the Gospel message? Another training day is planned for tomorrow.

Don't forget about our Junior Primary School Concert this Thursday.

In a few weeks' time the Management Team would like the congregation to adopt our values at GGLF. Here they are again for you to think about and discuss:




