Jesus Heals a Crippled Woman on the Sabbath Devotion Based On Luke 13:10-17

"There is a time and a place for everything!" I remember that being told to me many times as a child. I think the Synagogue leader had the same mind set - seeing only the breaking of the precious Sabbath law, and not the incredible shattering of a very real human tragedy. You would have to be a very unfeeling person not to get some twinge of wonder and joy seeing a person crippled for 18 years suddenly have the burden removed and ability restored. We are all capable of blinkered logic like the Leader showed. We are especially blinkered to our own faults.

There were many cripples in Israel but not all were healed, only those who came into Jesus path. But He never refused to heal anyone. Jesus' time to help was NOW. We are all crippled in some way. Sin and Satan cripple us. They steal our energy, they confound our thoughts, they confuse our understanding, they make us selfish, proud, arrogant and every other negative thing, leading to broken relationships, broken people, broken lives. But in Jesus all sin and Satanic influence is defeated. All that is crippling to our human natures can be healed, all our sins forgiven because Jesus has the power and the inclination to free us and restore our faith in Him. And He's ready now! As Scripture tells us, "Now is the day of salvation!" On Good Friday we heard Him say, "It is finished." Sin, death and Satan were defeated.

Without Jesus we are bent over and cannot straighten up at all but through the Holy Spirit Jesus comes to us to restore us as whole and wholesome children of God who will one day see the perfection of God's original design for each person He made. Imagine the joy and wonder that day!

Thank You Lord that You are always ready to help and heal. We need both. Amen.
