Before Worship

Our God Is Trustworthy!!

The three readings we have today all have a trust / trustworthiness element.

We either trust God or we don't! He knows when people sweep things under the carpet, use dishonest measures etc. and for those things done outside of trust in God, Amos tells us how God reacts, "I will never forget anything they have done". Scary stuff!

In Luke 16 Jesus implies that it is through our relationship with money that our trustworthiness is evident. The apostle James says it this way, "I will show you my faith by my deeds." Jam 2v18. People who trust God make friends with others using their wealth (and we are all wealthy in many ways despite how the bank balance looks). Service to others and love of God are inseparable.

Jesus clearly states in today's reading,"You cannot serve both God and money." The love of earthly wealth is in direct opposition to the love of God.

Jesus chose the story of the crooked yet shrewd manager to illustrate the prudent use of wealth. Our trust in God should lead us to make friends with others using all the blessings we have because we already have the hope of "eternal dwellings", of eternal life and we can't loose either if our trust is in Him.

Life will be made more enjoyable for all if we follow His example and serve each other.

Thank You Lord God that You are trustworthy and You serve us with Your 'wealth', the sacrificed life of your Son. Help us to live the same way. Amen.


GGLC Café Connect Volunteers


