## Before Worship

#### **Thankfulness**

One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan.

Luke 17:15-16

We all find being thankful a little hard. It is our human nature to continually strive for those things we do not have and focus on that rather than being thankful for the many blessings we already have. We can also fall victim to the destructive habit of comparing what we have to what those around us have. Almost always we see their apparent abundance and fail to see our own blessings.

So too with the lepers who were healed by Jesus' command. When they were suffering all they wanted was relief and they cried out to Jesus for healing. In his gracious wisdom, he healed all who asked and gave them a new life. Yet we see that nine of the 10 quickly forgot their previous predicament and went about seeking new things, apparently forgetting the source of their restoration. Only one was moved to give thanks and honour to Jesus as the giver of new life. Only one was thankful for what they had received.

Thankfulness and faith have a natural connection. As we give thanks we declare that Jesus is the source of our well-being and our hope, now and eternally. When we give thanks, our hearts are changed so that we delight in what we have rather than being unhappy with what we don't. Giving thanks brings us closer to the God who chose to surrender all for us.
