At the Reformation, Luther stood firm to correct the false teaching that had crept into the church. That teaching essentially focussed on the divisions between God and us and what we could do, in our strength, to overcome them. We know that Luther revealed the truth that salvation is a free gift of God and all his work. Our unity with God is driven by his love for us and that love is shown by his action. All we need to do is

respond in faith. That means putting our trust in him and his work rather than our own. Our relationship with God is transformed from one of fear to one of deep love.

As God's people we are also united by the work that he does among us. Our shared faith creates a bond that would be otherwise unknown. When we visit our friends in PNG, the unity that is a gift from God because of our faith in Jesus, draws us close and causes us to love authentically. Our cultural differences disappear because the unity of grace dwarfs things that come from human origin. When God's power and love are at work, all other things seem less important.

This Reformation Day may the Lord bless us richly with his presence so that we are united with him and each other through the grace that is lavished upon us.


