#### **Before worship**

Sometimes we are called upon to make judgements for ourselves on things we have limited knowledge of. The people of Jesus' hometown clearly saw His wisdom, power and authority and were astounded by it. But, they also 'knew' His family, His 'human' history and His occupation, things they could rely on! So, instead of being excited by the new things they saw and heard, they were deeply offended by Him and refused to believe He was a prophet who could be of help to them.

Jesus offended their sensibilities! Was their reaction a case of 'familiarity breeds contempt'? Perhaps there was some jealously there or maybe it was easier to keep the status quo. Maybe they were just frightened by their own lack of understanding. He'd pulled the mat out from under their feet!

What we do know is that Jesus was not deterred going instead from there, village to village, teaching, healing, helping others. And He commissioned twelve disciples to do them same. Now, 2000 years on we gather as Church, benefitting from that same Jesus who bestows His peace and salvation on us.

So what offends our sensibilities? What should offend them? Should it be those things that offended Him? Jesus still works in our world, sometimes in ways we don't understand. He still commissions others to bear His good news of peace and to be involved in His helping ministries. Dear Lord, thank You that You persevered in Your mission. We seek Your wisdom and

understanding that we be willing and equipped to share in Your work in the world. Amen
