Before worship

God's Will

With all wisdom and understanding, he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ. Ephesians 1:8-9

Many people love a good mystery. A gripping novel or a 'who-dunnit' movie thriller excites and entertains us as we're carried along with the story. One thing all great mystery stories have in common is a satisfactory resolution. No one enjoys a plot that fails to reveal the guilt and the motive of the protagonists. We need to know.

At the start of the letter to the Ephesians, Paul informs the congregation that the great mystery of God's will has been revealed; the most important story in history has been resolved in the person and work of Jesus. No more waiting for God's kingdom. His rule is here and his favour extends to all who wish to be under his authority. Sin and death have been defeated and God's Holy Spirit lives in believers, bringing eternity into the present. We know the story: Christmas, Easter, Pentecost and the universal church for the last 2,000 years. God wins, and because of our adoption as his children, we win too.

Still, we long to hear a personal word from God about His will for our individual lives. While we thrilled to be part of the meta-narrative of salvation, it's natural to want to hear that loving and powerful word from our heavenly Father. The good news is that our God is neither static nor silent. He speaks to his children with words of encouragement, hope, correction and purpose. Our responsibility is to know God and be open to his word for us.
