#### **Jesus Provides**

Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish. John 6:11

It is so easy for us to focus on what we don't have as opposed to what we do. It seems that we want gifts, abilities and even things that others have while overlooking the talents and blessings we have received. We see others as better or we see our situation as dire and wonder how we can cope with pressure. Jesus has lots to say about this attitude and it is shown very clearly in his miracle of feeding the 5,000.

We know the story; two small fish and five small loaves was all that the disciples could amass to satisfy thousands of weary, hungry followers of Jesus. They looked at the crowd then looked at the food and only saw the deficit. They didn't see the Son of God standing right beside them. Their gaze was firmly on what was not there rather than what, or who, was there. In the disciples hands, the bread and fish didn't look like much. But in Jesus' hands, the same food looked like an abundance. In his hands, bellies were full and leftovers abounded.

Jesus wants us to see the possibilities of our gifts in his hands. Being a Christian is trusting Jesus with everything we see as our own. It is understanding that whatever we have to offer will be more than enough when it is offered in his service and with his blessing. This is the way that Jesus provides. In the miracle story, Jesus could have instantly taken away the crowd's hunger or filled their stomachs. But he chose to provide through the offerings and the ministry of the disciples. Today is no different. Jesus wants to provide for us all as we partner with him and allow our gifts to be used for his glory and purpose. Just like the disciples we will find the overflow fills many baskets.
