Shield of Faith

In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Ephesians 6:16

Faith is at the heart of the Christian life. We know that we are saved by grace, through faith. Jesus says to those who he healed 'your faith has made you well'. Without faith, Christianity makes no sense. This is why Paul compares faith to a shield that covers us completely. Faith is complete confidence in our God, Jesus, and his intentions for good in our lives. It isn't positive thinking or wishful thinking; faith is knowing in our hearts that God is on our side, he is active in our life and we matter to him.

The bible talks about God as our protector and shield. In psalm 5, it is his actions that keep us from harm as his presence is described as a shield. Our part is to live that reality. This is the essence of our faith response to God's provision and protection. It's easy for us to say that we believe this or that but real faith sees us make life choices that are consistent with what we say we believe. When we believe that God is our shield we do not fear anything that those opposed to God would throw at us. We live with confidence and contentment as His people. This is lifting the shield of faith as we move forward in God's kingdom.



ROSEHILL GARDENS SYDNEY NSW | 2-7 OCTOBER 2018



Our General Synod logo is inspired by the journey of the Israelites, written in the book of Exodus. With every step of faith they took towards freedom and future – through good times and bad, in obedience or rebellion – they were held safely in the hands of God. As are we.

The 2018 General Synod will be examining a number of high level issues relevant to the ongoing health and vitality of the LCA. Among these will, once again, be the question of the ordination of women and men and the unity of the church. We will also consider our place in the international Lutheran community and the communion of infants. There will be many practical and structural issues on the agenda such as governance and administration, constitutions, compliance, church discipline and mission initiatives. The agenda will be quite full and each decision made will have an ongoing impact.



John Henderson (Bishop) is calling the LCA once more to prayer as we come together to place our future into God's hands, and discern his will for this church. So let's pray then, as a church, trusting that the church is safe in God's hands.

Thank you so much, heavenly Father, for sending us your Son Jesus, the Living Word. May he be in us, and we in him. Help us be faithful witnesses to his true light that shines on everyone.

As you have baptised us in your name and made us members of the body of your Son, keep us close to him and to one another as we prepare for our General Convention of Synod in Sydney. We can't hide our concerns and our fears from you. As we face of difficult decisions, some of us question our unity. You promise us there is no fear in love, because perfect love casts out fear. Give us that love, Lord, and help us put our fears aside, trusting you to reveal your truth.

Please help us always choose the loving path of compassion and respect that binds us together in your truth. For when we love one another, the whole world will know that we are your disciples. No matter how strongly we may believe we know your truth and a brother or sister is in error, don't let that stop our loving actions.

Teach us what you want us to know through your Word. Give us all grace to turn to you with open hearts, in repentance and prayer. Make us content to walk your way, with grace and faith, as followers of our brother Jesus.
